Coca-Cola Special English Seminar!

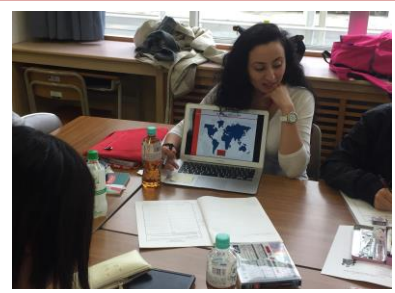

<October 15th>

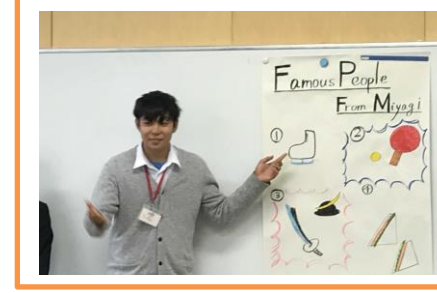
♦ Sekiko students asked international students questions about their carrier goals.
